【閑清庵 (Kanseian)】 This tearoom was built when the Bunka Hall was constructed as part of the Kanazawa 400th Anniversary project. It is made up of two sections: a main four-and-a-half-tatami room and an additional room with table and chairs. The main room is enclosed by two corridors (three- and four-tatami). If you remove all the partitions between the rooms, they can be used as one spacious twelve-tatami room.
